1. Their Pride v.10b

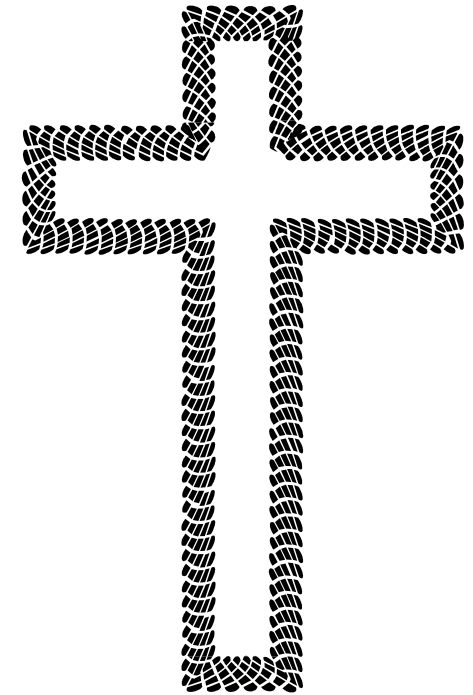
2. Their Practice/Partying v.13b
