"We want to share the good news with you that the formal checks of the Pumé New Testament have been completed! After fifteen intense, long days, our partners Merrill and Teresa, our Pumé language helper and a translation consultant finished the comprehension check of Luke, Philemon, Jude, 2 Peter, and 1, 2, and 3 John. Merrill and his helper have now reviewed and finalized the six epistles and are working on Luke....Because of the annual flooding that occurs during the rainy season, we are limited in when we can meet with our brethren. As a consequence, it will likely be two years before we have the completed New Testament and Old Testament portions printed and ready for presentation. We appreciate your prayers for us up to this point, and would ask that you praise God with us and continue in prayer so that there are no unnecessary delays in finishing this grand work."

3. The Miracle v.6-8

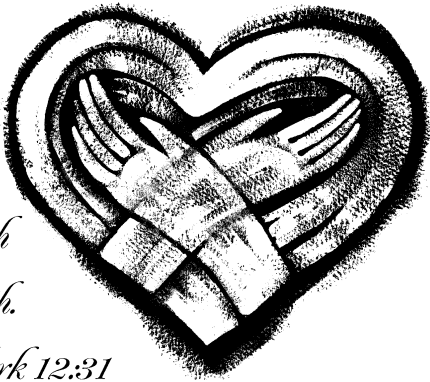
Conclusion - Be encouraged and believe that Jesus has compassion on you today.
