The Baptism of the King

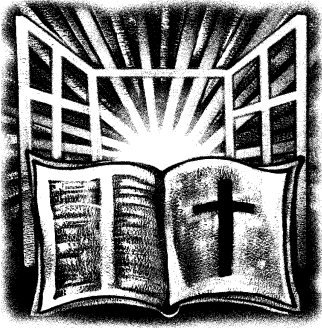
This morning we will endeavor to explain the reason why Jesus was baptized so that we would grow in our Christology and Soteriology.
