4. *The Mission Statement for Preaching/Teaching 1:12 3:1*

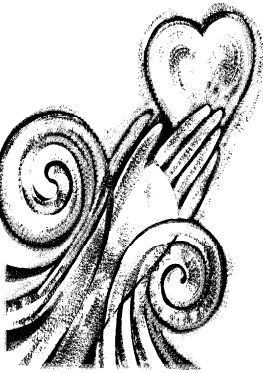
5. *The Day of the Lord 3:10*
