
Garnet and Charlene Dima will be giving a presentation of their recent trip to Israel at the 6:00 evening service.

Introduction/Review

- 1. So we have the prophetic Word made more sure v.19a
- 2. Pay attention to it v.19b
- 3. As to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts v.19c
- 4. No prophecy of Scripture is a matter of ones own interpretation v.20 (The origin is God not man)
- 5. For no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God v.21

Conclusion - Be confident that the Bible you have and hold is the very Word of God. Because of that, take heed to what it says..
