Jesus' Authority part 2

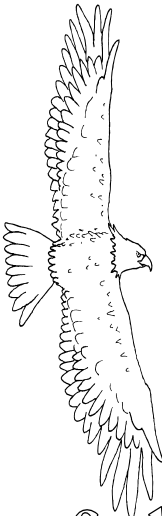
Today we are going to consider the authority of Jesus in His healing so that we would continue to learn more about Him and grow in our faith.
