1. Precious & Magnificent Promises

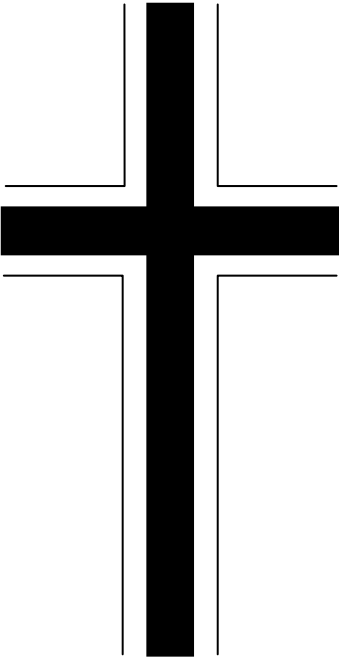
